2007 ANNUAL REPORT

Heart Gallery of New Mexico Foundation (HGNMF) partners with New Mexico's Children Youth and Families Department (CYFD) to supplement and enhance support of older foster children, the mildly disabled, and sibling groups by providing opportunities today and hope for tomorrow.

Funds are raised to: 1) Support Heart Gallery exhibitions of photographs by New Mexican photographers of hard to place foster children as an option for family planning and 2) Adoption Events to match foster children with potential adoptive parents. 3) Provide opportunities to enhance the lives of foster youth ages 11-21 and Sponsor Youth Advocates of New Mexico, a youth-led group of 16-21 year old foster youth who advocate for all foster children and broaden their own horizons. 4) Provide public information to encourage adoption or fostering a child as an option in family planning.

Contributions:

- \$197,282 includes:
 - Pledges awarded but not received
 - \$30,000 contracted by CYFD from the \$100,000 2007 Legislative Appropriation to Heart Gallery Programs that were initiated by HGNMF Board Members.
- 2007 expenses:

○ Programs:	\$105,767	67%
○ Administration:	\$19,892	13%
○ Fundraising and Events:	\$30,964	20%

In 2007, its first full year, HGNMF received the 501c3 designation, completed two successful fund raising events, and developed a respected and responsible organization actively participating with CYFD, foundations, individuals, businesses, and child service organizations to serve New Mexico's foster children:

- Opportunities provided to foster youth:
 - Sixteen youth adopted from four Heart Gallery Events
 - 200+ youth and adoptive families attended each of the four Heart Gallery Events.
 - Thirty youth and chaperones attended Aspen Santa Fe Ballet Nutcracker and lunch; youth received Nutcracker Dolls and met the cast back stage
 - Elijah from Rio Arriba County attended People to People Ambassador Program in Washington DC.
 - Damien from Curry County participated with his team in the National Football Championship

- Famish from Silver Springs received a guitar and amplifier from HGNMF in partnership with AML Foundation to continue playing with a Christian rock band.
- Matthew a 14 year old in Albuquerque, separated from his four siblings, received art supplies.
- Jessica received a new set of clothes to wear for her Heart Gallery picture.
- Alanna from Curry County was able to join her school band at Band Camp in Dallas.
- Chris from Bernalillo County received start up funds to begin his college career at an art school in California.
- Clarissa at UNM entering Nursing School received a much needed cell phone.
- An 18 year old and her 3 year old son from Rio Rancho received a month's apartment rent until CYFD could provide a safe home for them.
- Casey attended Pathways to Adulthood Conference in Minnesota for foster youth
- Megan, an accomplished foster youth from Valencia County, received a donated laptop computer, printer, software, cartridges, paper, etc. to use for advance English courses in pursuit of college. (Foster parents have since provided internet for her.)
- A 16 year old from Santa Fe who is getting her diploma at Job Corp in Roswell received a donated lap top computer to help with her studies.
- HGNMF Sponsorship of Youth Advocates of New Mexico facilitated:
 - Increased enrollment from 5-10 to 24 regulars who meet in Santa Fe monthly.
 - Visit to Shidoni Foundry, glassblowing workshop, and pewter workshop
 - Attendance at Santa Fe Mountain Center
 - Attendance at Etiquette/Life skills class with seated lunch
 - Tour of Roundhouse and introduction on Senate floor by Senators Carlos Cisneros and Steve Komadina.
 - Participation in Children Law Institute; sponsorship shared between AML Foundation and HGNMF.
 - Lunch and support provided as needed at monthly meetings
- Provided new portable displays to the five adoption/foster parent CYFD Recruiters (plus one for HGNMF) to improve their capacity to advertise and promote adoption as an option to family planning.
- Established in partnership with CYFD a permanent Heart Gallery exhibition at the Bill and Barbara Richardson Pavilion at UNM Children's Hospital, Albuquerque.
- Established Heart Gallery exhibition in retail space in the Santa Fe Arcade
- Co-sponsored Adoption Walk on the Santa Fe Plaza and Exhibition at Gerald Peters Gallery following the Plaza event.
- Helped host the Heart Gallery of America's first annual meeting.
